Annex B - Meeting Standing Orders

1. The union is committed to a non-hierarchical structure under the principles of direct member democracy.
2. Motions may be raised verbally during any members meetings.
3. Verbally raised motions must be adopted by a simple majority of members in the meeting.
4. Adopted motions must then be submitted in writing within 2 weeks of the date of the initial meeting.
5. Written motions will be circulated to all relevant members by a member nominated by the Executive.
6. Relevant members will be the following options by way of an online ballot:
 - 6.1. Accept.
 - 6.2. Reject.
 - 6.3. Amend.
7. Motions will be deemed to be accepted or rejected following support by a simple majority.
8. Members wishing to amend adopted motions must submit amendments writing within 1 week of the close of the ballot.
9. Amendments will be circulated to relevant in the order they were received, composited by agreement with the submitting members and voted on accordingly via electronic ballot.
10. Should no amendments be received before the 1-week deadline the motion will stand or fall according to the original vote.
